\*The term "Band-Aid" means the slightly sweet, vaguely chemical smell associated with medical-grade plastics. It is often found in wines from terroirs in South America. Provided a wine has a sufficient concentration of fruit aromas and complex tertiary characteristics, Band-Aid is a Good Thing. Otherwise, it smells like cheap lipstick.
